Global Perspectives Travel Immunization Requirements

The mandatory vaccinations are necessary for international travel. The highly recommended vaccinations are identified by a comprehensive travel medicine database specifically related to international health and travel as moderate risks to travelers. These may include but are not limited to country, region, elevation, province, and city.

Jamaica Deaf Studies May 13-21, 2023

Mandatory:

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccines x 2 or positive titers
- Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine x 2 or positive titer

Highly Recommended:

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis) vaccine; needs to be updated every 10 years
- Typhoid vaccine

Travelers' Diarrhea is considered moderate risk
