### Global Perspectives Travel Immunization Requirements

The mandatory vaccinations are necessary for international travel. The highly recommended vaccinations are identified by a comprehensive travel medicine database specifically related to international health and travel as moderate risks to travelers. These may include but are not limited to country, region, elevation, province, and city.

## **Ecuador Counseling**

**March 2-12, 2023**

### **Mandatory:**

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccines x 2 or positive titers
- Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine x 2 or positive titer
- 

### **Highly Recommended:**

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis) vaccine, needs updating every 10 years
- Hepatitis A vaccines x2
- Typhoid vaccine
- Mosquito avoidance

**\*\*Mosquito protection/avoidance recommended due to risk of Chikungunya Fever, Dengue Fever and Zika Virus. Risk for Chagas'Dz (Chagas bug "kissing bug")\*\***

**\*\*Travelers' Diarrhea is considered high risk\*\***
