

Global Perspectives Travel Immunization Requirements

The mandatory vaccinations are necessary for international travel. The highly recommended vaccinations are identified by a comprehensive travel medicine database specifically related to international health and travel as moderate risks to travelers. These may include but are not limited to country, region, elevation, province, and city.

India

May 27-June 10, 2023

Mandatory:

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccines x 2 or positive titers
- Varicella (chickenpox) vaccines x 2 or positive titer

Highly Recommended:

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis) vaccine, needs updating every 10 years
- Hepatitis A vaccines (series of 2)
- Typhoid vaccine
- Japanese Encephalitis vaccine
- Malaria Prophylaxis

****Mosquito protection/avoidance recommended due to risk of Chikungunya Fever, Dengue Fever, Zika Virus, Filariasis-Lymphatic****

****Travelers' Diarrhea is considered high risk****
