How long of a trip is preferred?

What is the money situation?

- The most economical option is top priority.

- Financial aid is available.
- The trip price is covered.

What type of climate is preferred? Tropical, dry, cold.

What activities are preferred?

- Independent travel.
- Language instruction.
- History and heritage study.
- Academic Research.
- Missions, outreach.
- Sightseeing: landmarks, castles, cathedrals.
- Service learning.

- Outdoor recreation: hiking, skiing, scuba diving.
- Art: museums, orchestras, symphonies, drama.
